What is the Agrarian Country Land Preserve?

All lands owned by Agrarian Country are dedicated to the preservation of our natural land and water resources and for the benefit of our community and the Agrarian Country mission.

How will the funds be used?

- Pays for the purchase of land for Agrarian Country use
- Pays for infrastructure: roads, utilities, bridges, and parking
- Pays for the Conservation District Management Master Plan implementation
- Pays for landscaping, trees, shrubs, wetlands, ponds, fencing, and ground cover
- Pays for land beautification, signage, and security
- Pays for environmental and waste management implementation
- Pays for the maintenance costs of land and infrastructure
- Pays for endowment for land preserve and agriculture education

Agrarian Country Land Preserve – Phase I: Main Campus

- **Total Acres:** 300
- **Contribution Blocks:** 14,000 blocks at 1,000 square feet of land per block
- **Minimum Contribution:** \$500 (one-time or over-time pledges). Contributors may contribute as many contribution blocks as desired.
- **Total Phase I Campaign Fund: \$7,000,000**

- Satisfaction of preserving agricultural and forest land for perpetuity
- Satisfaction of supporting the Agrarian Country mission
- Recognition in the Agrarian Country Hall of Fame – life story
- Recognition at the annual Agrarian Country Land Stewardship Celebration

- Receive a plaque based on level of contribution
- Complimentary Agrarian Country membership with benefits - based on level of contribution.
- Receive a tax deduction in accordance with IRS regulations for a 501(c)3 public charity

- The Agrarian Country Land Fund will be administered by the **Agrarian Country Executive Council** and overseen by the **Agrarian Country Board of Directors**
- The Agrarian Country Board of Directors will be advised by the **Agrarian Country Land Preserve Council**
- Agrarian Country is subject to local, state, and federal regulations pertaining to land use, fund use, and activities
